Grateful Plate Gala Brings Community Leaders and Local Celebrities Together to Solve Hunger

Keynote Alex Hart-Upendo, the 12-year-old founder of Build-A-Bow LLC from Racine, will share his journey from homelessness and hunger to starting his own business.

MILWAUKEE, **WI** (**April 29**, **2019**) – More than 350 business and community leaders will gather **Thursday**, **May 23** at the Marcus Center for the Performing Arts for the annual Grateful Plate Gala, presented by **Walmart**, to help solve hunger in our community. WHY: In eastern Wisconsin, 1 in 7 people don't have enough to eat. These

numbers are even worse for children (1 in 5 facing hunger) who will soon face a summer without access to school meal programs. The event is held

in Milwaukee County, where every child is eligible for school meal programs. When school is not in session, they lose access to these

programs and the vital nutrition they provide.
